- (3) Pursuant to section 52 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 the Council and the Owner have agreed to complete this agreement

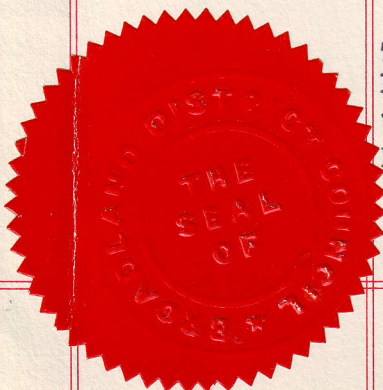
NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows:-

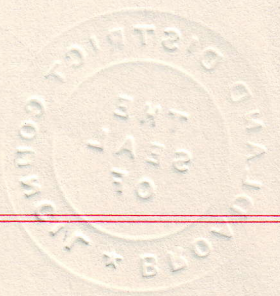

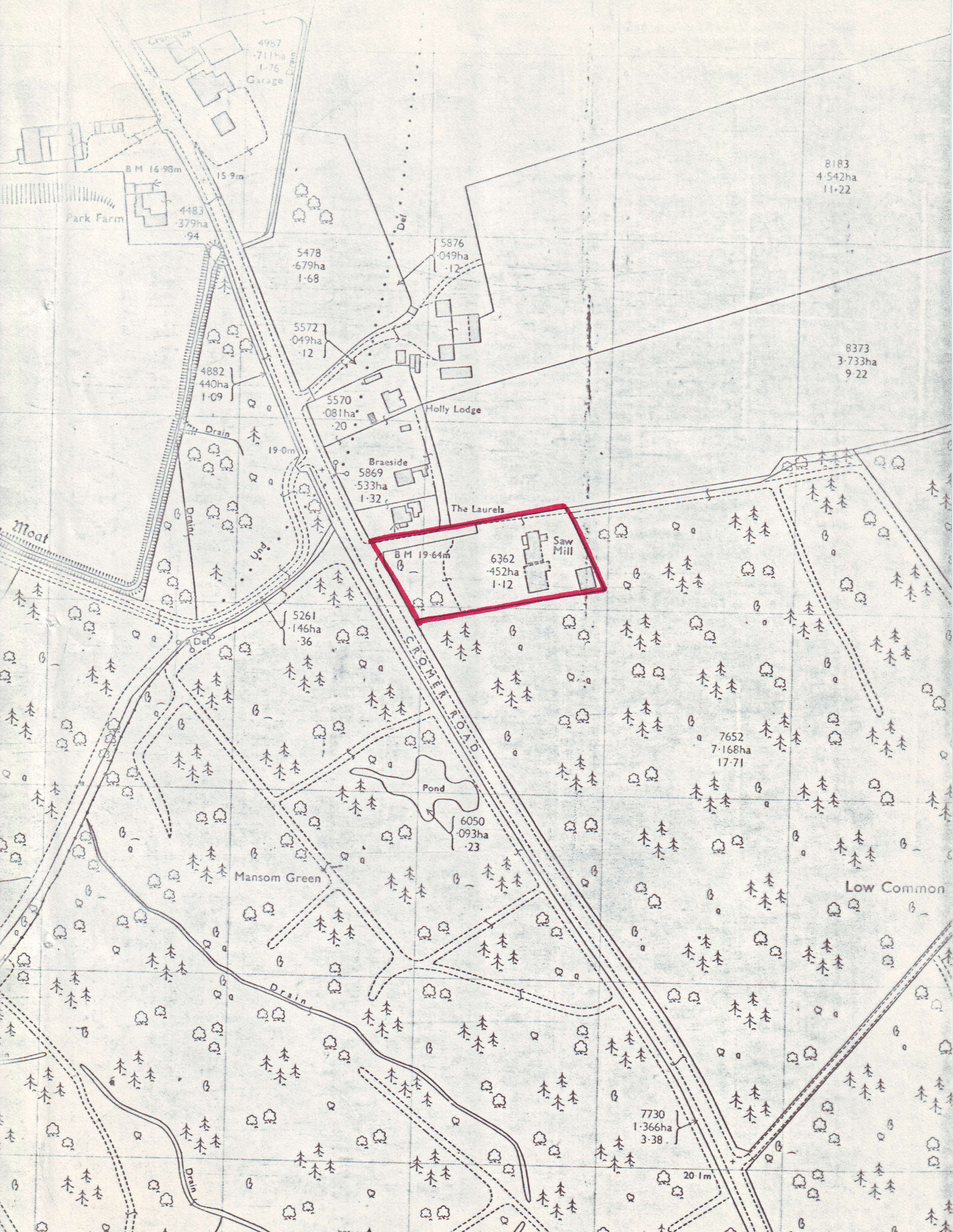
