WHEREAS

- (1) The Council is the Local Planning Authority for the purpose of this agreement
- (2) The Owner is seised in unencumbered fee simple in possession of the property described in the First Schedule hereto (hereinafter called "the property")
- (3) The Owner has applied to the Council under reference no. 78.1071 for planning permission for development to be carried out on the property
- (4) The Council and the Owner have agreed subject to planning permission being granted in consequence of the aforesaid application to enter into this Agreement pursuant to Section 52 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows:

1. Subject to planning permission being granted in consequence of application no. 78.1071 and pursuant to Section 52 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 the Owner hereby agrees declares and covenants with the Council that from the date on which the development for which the aforesaid planning permission shall be granted is completed the property shall permanently be subject to the conditions specified in the Second Schedule hereto restricting or regulating the development or use of the property

2. The expressions "the Council" and "the Owner" shall where the context so admits include their respective successors in title and assigns

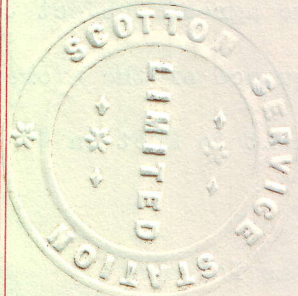

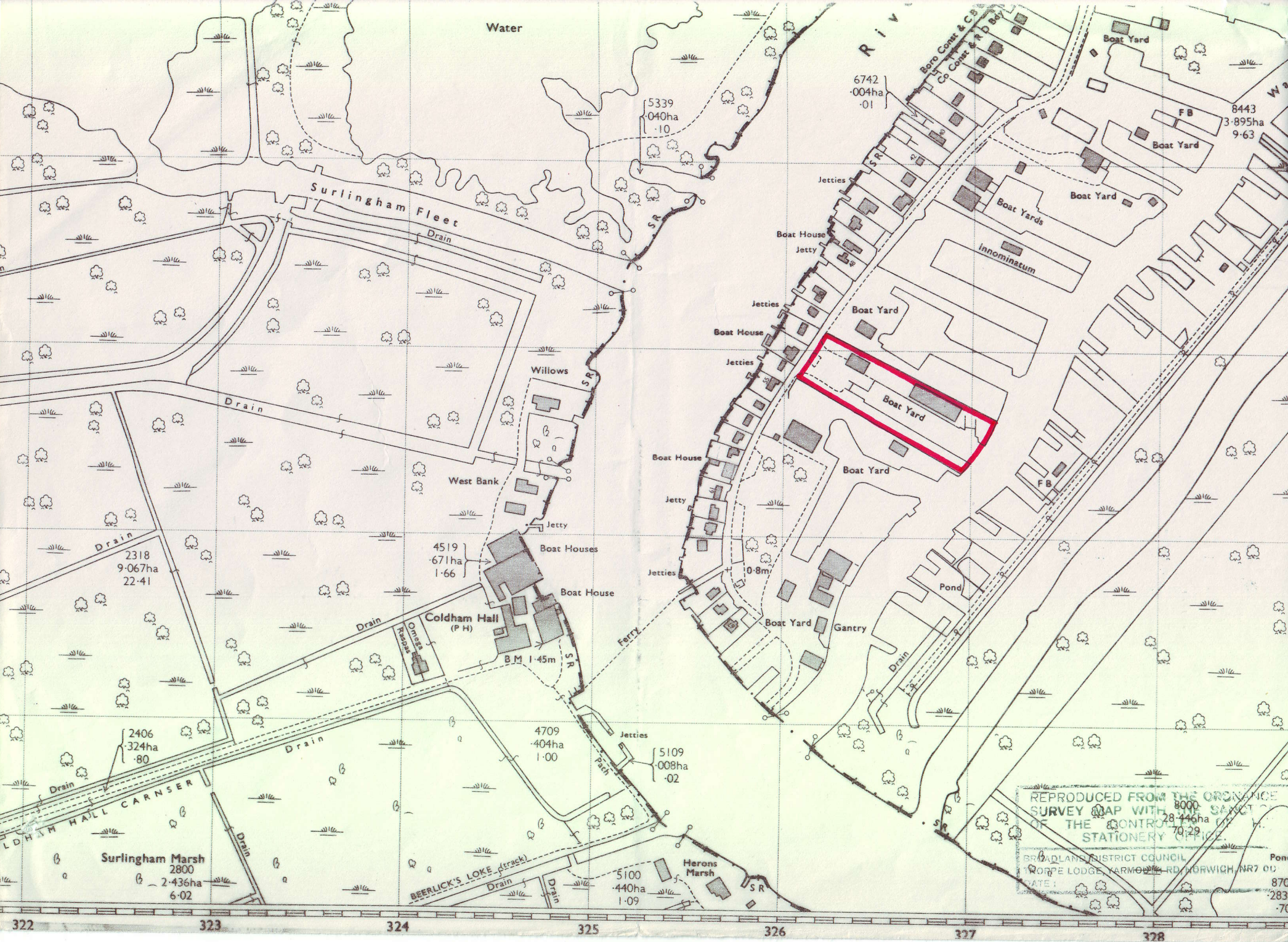
