WHEREAS:-

- (1) In accordance with Section 101 and 102 of the Local Government Act 1972 the Authority exercises the functions of the local planning authority for the purposes of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 for the area within which the land shown edged red on the annexed plan (hereinafter referred to as "the said land") is situated






