

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDERS

1973 to 1974

DIRECTION RESTRICTING PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS the South Norfolk District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") being the appropriate local planning authority as defined by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973 as amended ~~by the Town and Country Planning General Development (Amendment) Order 1974~~ (hereinafter together called "the Order") are of the opinion that development of the description set out in Schedule 1 hereto should not be carried out on the land specified in Schedule 2 hereto unless permission therefor is granted on an application made in that behalf under the Order.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the said Article 4 HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to development of the description set out in Schedule 1 hereto on the land specified in Schedule 2 hereto.

SCHEDULE 1 REFERRED TO

The erection or construction of gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure not exceeding 1 metre in height where abutting on a highway used by vehicular traffic or 2 metres in height in any other case, and the maintenance, improvement or other alteration of any gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure, being development comprised within class II paragraph 1 referred to in Schedule 1 to the Order and not being development comprised within any other class.
