1. 2022/0867	One additional public representation has been received in support of the application setting out: As one of the properties closest to the proposed development (as confirmed by other public comments) I was surprised to read that the local councillor stated ' There is widespread local concern about this'. I do not believe this is the case. I would suggest there is a tiny amount of very vocal local concern but the majority welcome this essential infrastructure and see it as part of our drive towards a cleaner planet. There is a balance of risks - the small possibility of a fire on the site against the certainty that without this type of initiative we will hasten climate change. If this application is refused on the basis of 'local opposition' it will be a travesty of the democratic process.	23
