

# NOTICE OF ELECTION

## Election of a Police and Crime Commissioner for the **Norfolk** Police Area on 16 July 2026

---

1. An election is to be held for a Police and Crime Commissioner for the Norfolk Area.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the office of the Police Area Returning Officer (PARO), Broadland District Council, Horizon Business Centre, Peachman Way, Broadland Business Park, Norwich, NR7 0WF, during the times stated below.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered in person by appointment only to the Police Area Returning Officer, Broadland Business Park, Norwich, NR7 0WF, between the hours of 10am and 4pm on any working day after the date of this notice, but not later than **4pm on Friday, 19 June 2026**. Appointments can be arranged by email [elections@southnorfolkandbroadland.gov.uk](mailto:elections@southnorfolkandbroadland.gov.uk) or telephone 01508 533704.
4. In order to be validly nominated, candidates (or someone acting on their behalf) must deposit the sum of £5000 with the PARO by **Friday, 19 June 2026**. This sum may be in the form of an online BACS payment, card, cash or bankers draft (made payable to Broadland District Council) and must be delivered to the Police Area Returning Officer at the Horizon Centre. Funds must be cleared before the nomination is considered valid.
5. If the election is contested, the poll will take place on **Thursday, 16 July 2026**.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer (for addresses see below) by **midnight on Tuesday, 30 June 2026**. Applications can be made online at: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday, 1 July 2026** if they are to be effective for this election. Applications can be made online at: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote>
8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's document valid for this election must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday, 8 July 2026**. Applications can be made online at: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate>
9. Applications for a proxy vote at this election must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday, 8 July 2026** Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote>
10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by not later than **5pm on Thursday, 16 July 2026**. Note: there are specific criteria that apply to emergency proxy applications.
