South Norfolk Council

Referendum on the adoption of the Newton Flotman Neighbourhood Plan on 4 September 2025

1. A referendum will be held on 4 September 2025 to decide on the question below:
‘Do you want South Norfolk Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Newton Flotman to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?’
2. Applications be included in the register of electors for this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, Horizon Centre, Peachman Way, Broadland Business Park, Norwich, NR7 0WF by **midnight on Monday, 18 August 2025**. 3. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Tuesday, 19 August 2025** if they are to be effective for this election. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote>
4. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector’s document valid for this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday, 27 August 2025**. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate>
5. Applications for a proxy vote at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday, 27 August 2025**. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote>
6. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by not later than **5pm on Thursday, 4 September 2025** . Note: there are specific criteria that apply to emergency proxy applications.
