





Welcome to Tots2Teens' Winter holiday brochure. Tots2Teens offers a wide range of activities for young people aged 5 to 16 years during the school holidays.

We are a Big Norfolk Holiday Fun provider. If your child is eligible for means-tested free school meals, they will be able to attend up to 4 of our sessions during the Winter holidays for free.

Please book online, entering promotional code BNHFWINTER.

During the Winter holidays, all participants will be provided with a free lunch and snacks at all sessions.* Once a booking has been made, you will receive an email with details of the lunch options to choose from. We cater for all dietary requirements and allergies.

We offer a 50% reduction on all activities for Broadland households claiming means tested benefits. These include Council Tax reduction, Housing Benefit, Universal Credit, Incomebased Jobseeker's Allowance, Income-related Employment and Support Allowance, Income Support, Child Tax Credit, and Working Tax Credit. Please let the booking team know if you are eligible for this discount.

Payment must be made by credit or debit card at the time of booking.

All fees are non-refundable, unless we are able to fill the space.

In the event that we have to cancel a session, we will endeavour to give at least a week's notice and a refund will be provided.

If you wish for your child/ren to attend and leave an activity without an adult, we will require written permission from the parent/carer stating this intention before the date of the relevant activity.

Please note: Children may only be dropped off and registered from 10 minutes before the start of the session.

STAY AND PLAY WITH AUTISM EXPLIRERS

Please do not bring any electronic games or mobiles to the sessions.

At their Tots2Teens debut, have a day exploring the festive period using your senses in this new SEND specialised play session. Suitable for children between ages 5 - 12, this stay and play session welcomes children of all requirements to come and enjoy the festive season in an exciting new way.

This is a drop-in session; families are welcome to join from any time between 09:30 – 15:00 (last entry) and can stay for as long as they like. There will be some free goodies up for grabs and all-round festive cheer for the whole family. Siblings are also welcome to join in the fun!

Due to health and safety regulations, there will be a maximum capacity of 20 children in the venue at any given time meaning during busy periods, there may be a brief waiting period. This is a stay and play session meaning parents/ guardians must stay with their children throughout the duration of the stay. No diagnosis is needed to attend this session. Lunches will not be provided on this day but all visiting families will be issued with a foodbag to take home.


