- 2. The County Council and the District Council HEREBY JOINTLY AND SEVERALLY COVENANT with the Owner that notwithstanding anything by them or by any person through whom they derive Title otherwise than by purchase of value made done executed or omitted or knowingly suffered they the County Council and the District Council have full power to release the Owner and its successors in title and the premises and every part thereof from the Covenant
- 3. That the parties hereto hereby agree and declare that save as herein mentioned the Section 52 Agreement shall remain in full force and effect in respect of the Premises so far as the same is still subsisting and capable of taking effect
