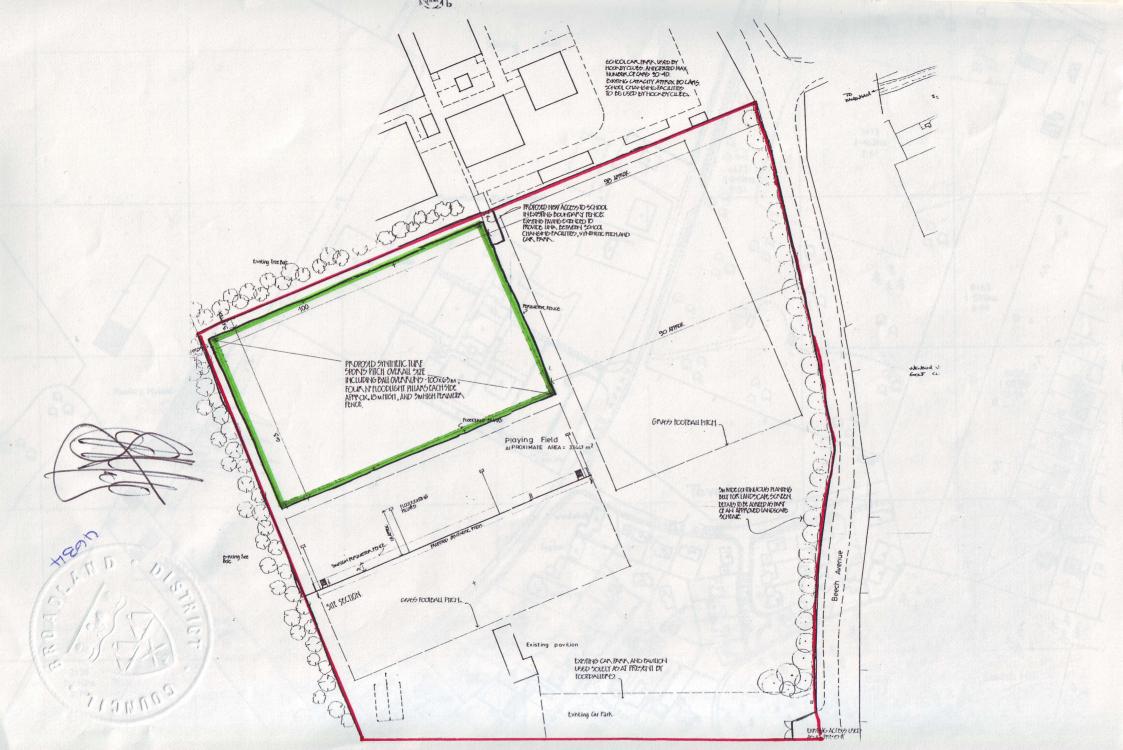

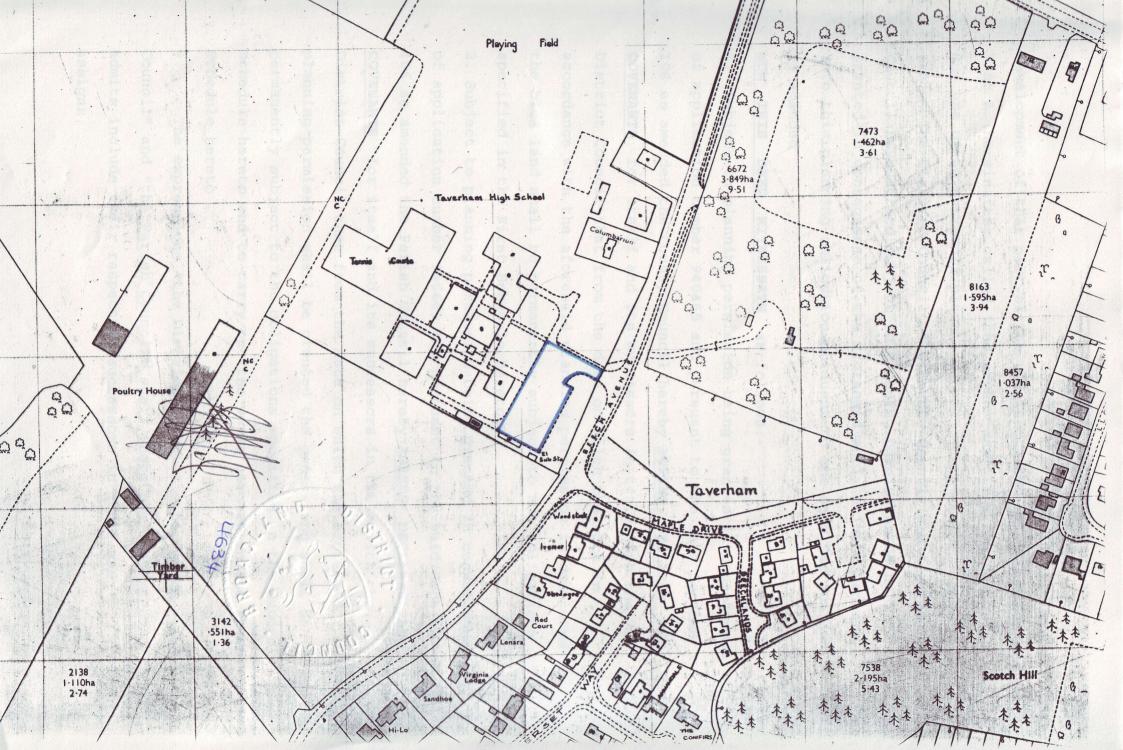

THIS AGREEMENT is made the Twenty-severth One thousand nine hundred and ninety-four BETWEEN BROADLAND DISTRICT COUNCIL of Thorpe Lodge Yarmouth Road Thorpe St. Andrew in the County of Norfolk (hereinafter called "the District Council") of the first part NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL of County Hall Martineau Lane in the City of Norwich (hereinafter called "the County Council") of the second part and TAVERHAM PARISH COUNCIL of Taverham in the County of Norfolk (hereinafter called "the Parish Council") of the third part.

WHEREAS:-

- The obligations imposed by this Deed are both planning (1) obligations for the purposes of Section 106 of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 as amended by Section 12 of the Planning and Compensation Act 1991
- The District Council is the Local Planning Authority by whom these obligations are enforceable
- The Parish Council is seised in fee simple absolute in possession of the land shown for identification purposes only edged red on the plan annexed hereto (hereinafter called "Plan A") situate off Beech Avenue in the Parish of Taverham in the County of Norfolk (hereinafter called "the red land")
- (4) The County Council is seised in fee simple absolute in possession of (inter alia) the land shown for identification purposes only edged blue on the plan annexed hereto (hereinafter called "Plan B") situate off Beech Avenue aforesaid (hereinafter called "the blue land")
- The Parish Council has applied to the District Council under reference number 940465 for planning permission for the





development of that part of the red land shown hatched green on Plan A (hereinafter called "the green land") for the provision and use of an Astroturf pitch

(6) The District Council the County Council and the Parish Council have agreed subject to planning permission being granted in consequence of the aforesaid application to enter into this planning obligation pursuant to the said Section 106 as amended

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows:-

- 1. Subject to planning permission being granted in consequence of application number 940465 and pursuant to the said Section 106 as amended the County Council hereby AGREES DECLARES AND COVENANTS for itself and its successors in title with the District Council that from the date on which the work in accordance with the aforesaid planning permission is completed the blue land shall be permanently subject to the obligations specified in the First Schedule hereto.
- 2. Subject to planning permission being granted in consequence of application number 940465 and pursuant to the said Section 106 as amended the Parish Council hereby AGREES DECLARES AND COVENANTS for itself and its successors in title with the District Council that from the date on which the aforesaid planning permission shall be granted the green land shall be permanently subject to the obligations specified in the Second Schedule hereto and to carry out the works set out in the Third Schedule hereto
- 3. The expressions "the District Council" "the County Council" and "the Parish Council" shall where the context so admits include their respective successors in Title and assigns.

3. This document is executed as a Deed and is delivered on the date stated at the beginning of this Deed

IN WITNESS whereof the District Council and the

County Council have caused their respective Common Seals to be hereunto affixed and two members of the Parish Council have executed this deed in pursuance of Section 14 (3) of the Local Government Act 1972 the day and year first before written

THE FIRST SCHEDULE referred to

To take all possible steps to ensure that parking spaces are reserved for the stipulated number of vehicles (thirty) in an appropriate part of the blue land as shall from time to time be identified by the Governing Body of Taverham High School and designated for use in connection with the green land during such periods of time as the car parking spaces are required by the users of the green land

THE SECOND SCHEDULE referred to

To give priority of use of the Astroturf pitch to the Governing Body of Taverham High School and all others authorised by it during normal school terms until 5.30 p.m. on weekdays. At other times such use will be by agreement.

THE THIRD SCHEDULE referred to

- 1. To define on the ground the car parking area referred to in the First Schedule.
- 2. To provide and display a means of informing all other car park users the days dates and times that the car parking spaces are required by the users of the green land.

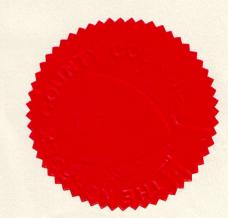
