- (1) By an Agreement (hereinafter called "the Agreement") dated the 27th day of September, 1977, and made between the Council of the one part and the Owner of the other part pursuant to Section 52 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 the Owner agreed declared and covenanted with the Council that the property (hereinafter called "the Property") described in the First Schedule thereto shall permanently or until planning permission is given on a planning application for some other purpose be subject to the conditions (restricting or regulating the development or use of the land) specified in the Second Schedule thereto.

contained in paragraph 3 insofar only as it relates to the use of the health food regaurant facility referred to in paragraph 1(b)(xi) of the Second Schedule to the Agreement, to the intent that the covenants on the part of the Owner contained in the said Agreement and the remaining conditions of the said Second Schedule shall remain in force

(4) In consideration of the premises the Council have agreed to release the Owner and the property from the said covenants in the manner hereinafter appearing

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows:-

In pursuance of the said Agreement the Council hereby releases the Owner and his successors in title and the property and every part thereof from the conditions and covenants contained in the Agreement as specified in the First Schedule hereto
