

Council Tax and Budget Information 2021/22

Council Tax

South Norfolk Council has set a budget which funds the services provided by the District and which increases the level of Council Tax to £160.00 per year for a Band D property. South Norfolk Council also sends out Council Tax bills on behalf of other bodies – Norfolk County Council, Norfolk Police and Crime Commissioner and Parish/Town Councils and has no control over the level of Council Tax set by these bodies.

Norfolk County Council is the adult social care authority for Norfolk and the increase in its Council Tax for 2021/22 includes 2% for adult social care expenditure. For more information please visit:

Council Tax bills will vary depending on which Parish/Town you live in (see Pages 5 to 7). For a Band D property they will range from £1,910.95 to £2,116.80.

Bills for properties in other bands will vary in accordance with the relevant proportions of Band D values as shown below.
