Supplementary Planning Document : Guidance for the delivery of a Food and Agriculture Hub for Broadland and South Norfolk

Adoption Statement – July 2014

In accordance with Regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is given that South Norfolk Council adopted the Supplementary Planning Document: Guidance for the delivery of a Food and Agriculture Hub for Broadland and South Norfolk (the Food Hub SPD) on 19 May 2014. The SPD was subsequently adopted by Broadland District Council on 10 July 2014.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for a judicial review of the decision. Any such application must me made promptly and in any event not later than three months after the date of adoption.

What is the Food Hub SPD?

The SPD sets out the main considerations that will apply to any proposal for a food and agricultural sector "hub" in the Broadland district and South Norfolk local planning authority areas.

The SPD supplements Policy 5: The Economy in the Joint Core Strategy (JCS) for Broadland, Norwich and South Norfolk Joint Core Strategy, adopted in March 2011. As such, this SPD does not create new planning policy, but it provides further interpretation and guidance on the application of the JCS policy, and so will be a material consideration in the determination of an application for planning permission.

Twenty-five responses were received during consultation on the draft SPD between October and December 2013 which the Councils took these responses into account in preparing the adopted SPD.
