SOUTH NORFOLK LOCAL PLAN LONG STRATTON AREA ACTION PLAN – ADOPTION STATEMENT

In accordance with Regulations 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, and Regulation 16 of the Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes Regulations 2004, **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the South Norfolk Local Plan – Long Stratton Area Action Plan (LSAAP) was formally adopted by South Norfolk Council on 26 May 2016. The adoption followed a resolution passed at the meeting of Full Council on 23 May 2016 to adopt the LSAAP, with effect from 26 May 2016.

The LSAAP replaces the remaining 'saved' policies of the 2003 South Norfolk Local Plan. The LSAAP sets out the policies to guide development and change in and around Long Stratton for the period to 31 March 2026.

The LSAAP was subject to examination by an independent Inspector, appointed by the Secretary of State. The Inspector's Report (received on 26 April 2016) concluded that, with a number of main modifications, the LSAAP is capable of adoption. Pursuant to section 23 (3) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (the Act), all the Inspector's recommended modifications to the Regulation 19 (of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2012) draft LSAAP have been incorporated into the adopted LSAAP along with additional (minor) modifications made by South Norfolk Council. The Inspector's main modifications are set out in Appendix A of her report, with the consequent Policies Map changes set out in Appendix B.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the LSAAP may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers conferred by Part 2 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 or that a procedural requirement of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 or its associated Regulations has not been complied with. Any such application must be made and recorded as received no later than six weeks after the date of adoption by the Council, namely 7 July 2016.
