

THIS PLANNING OBLIGATION is made the *twenty-eighth* day of *February* One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two BETWEEN BROADLAND DISTRICT COUNCIL of Thorpe Lodge Yarmouth Road Thorpe St. Andrew in the County of Norfolk (hereinafter called "the Council") of the one part and THE NATIONAL TRUST FOR PLACES OF HISTORIC INTEREST OR NATURAL BEAUTY of 36 Queen Anne's Gate London SW1H 9AS (hereinafter called "the Owner") of the other part

WHEREAS:-

- (1) The obligations imposed by this Deed are planning obligations for the purposes of Section 106 of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 as amended by Section 12 of the Planning and Compensation Act 1991
- (2) The Council is the Local Planning Authority by whom these obligations are enforceable
- (3) The Owner is seised in fee simple absolute in possession of (inter alia) the property described in the First Schedule hereto (hereinafter called "the Property")
- (4) The Owner has applied to the Council under reference number 91.1384 for planning permission for development to be carried out on the Red Land hereinafter described
- (5) The Council and the Owner have agreed subject to planning permission being granted in consequence of the aforesaid application to enter into this planning obligation pursuant to the said Section 106 as amended

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows:-

1. SUBJECT to planning permission being granted in consequence of application number 91.1384 and pursuant to the



said Section 106 as amended the Owner hereby AGREES DECLARES AND COVENANTS for itself and its successors in title with the Council that from the date on which the aforesaid planning permission shall be granted the Blue Land hereinafter described shall be permanently subject to the obligations specified in the Second Schedule hereto

2. THE expressions "the Council" and "the Owner" shall where the context so admits include their respective successors in Title and assigns

3. THIS document is executed as a Deed and is delivered on the date stated at the beginning of this Deed

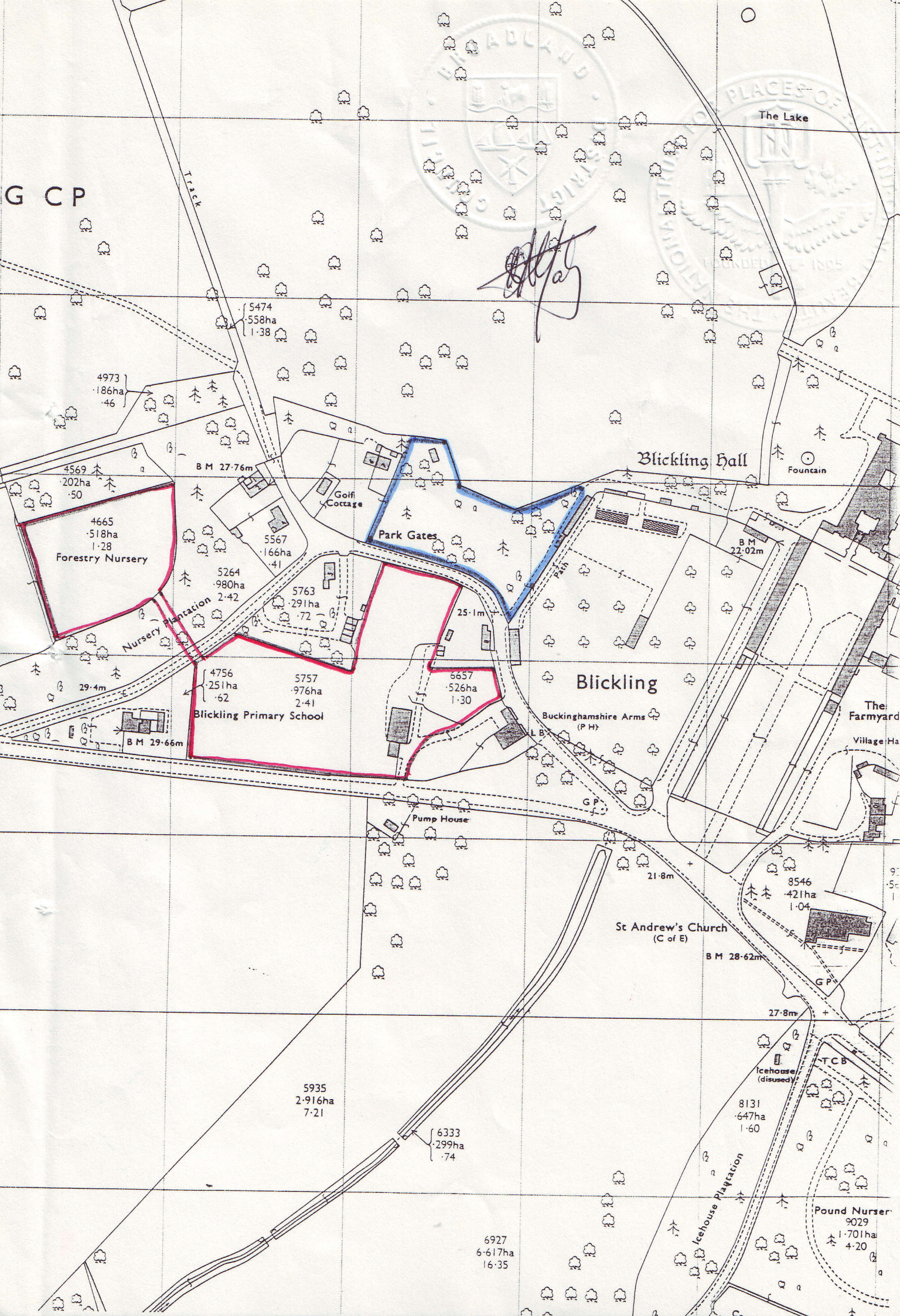


