I do not believe this is the case. I would suggest there is a tiny amount of very vocal local concern but the majority welcome this essential infrastructure and see it as part of our drive towards a cleaner planet. There is a balance of risks - the small possibility of a fire on the site against the certainty that without this type of initiative we will hasten climate change.</p> <p>If this application is refused on the basis of 'local opposition' it will be a travesty of the democratic process.</p>	23
