

Level 3 first aid re-qualification

Suitable for anyone who has a valid and current first aid at work certificate. this course includes revision of all topics covered in the Level 3 first aid at work course. It also covers updates on changes to health and safety legislation or best practice from the last three years and meets the requirements of the HSE. To attend this course your certificate must not have expired by more than three months. If a certificate has expired, that person will not be a gualified workplace first aider.
