Town and Country Planning
General Development Orders 1977 and 1980

Direction Restricting Permitted Development

WHEREAS the Council of the District of Broadland in the County of Norfolk being the appropriate Local Planning Authority within the meaning of article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Orders 1977 and 1980 are of the opinion that development of the descriptions set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on land at the White Horse Inn, The Street in the Parish of Brundall in the said County of Norfolk being the land shown edged red on the plan annexed hereto unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Orders 1977 and 1980

AND WHEREAS the Council are further of the opinion that development of the said descriptions would constitute a threat to the amenities of their area and that the provisions paragraph 3(b) of the said article 4 should apply to this direction

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the said article 4 hereby direct that the permission granted by article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Orders 1977 and 1980 shall not apply to development on the said land of the descriptions set out in the Schedule hereto

THIS DIRECTION is made in pursuance of the provisions of paragraph (3)(b) of the said article 4 and shall remain in force until and including the tenth day of January one thousand nine hundred and eighty two (being six months from the date of this direction) and will then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment before that date

Schedule

The use on not more than fourteen days in total in any calendar year of land for the purposes of

the holding of markets and the erection or placing of moveable structures on the said land for the purposes of that use,

being development comprised within paragraph 2 of Class IV of the first Schedule to the said orders and not being development comprised within any other class.
