(CAISTOR ST.EDMUND NO.1) 1978


WHEREAS -

- (1) the South Norfolk District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") being the appropriate local planning authority as defined by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 (hereinafter called "the Order") are of the opinion that development of the description set out in Schedule 1 hereto should not be carried out on the land specified in Schedule 2 hereto unless permission therefor is granted on an application made in that behalf under the Order.
- (2) the Council are further of the opinion that the said development would constitute a threat to the amenities of their area and that paragraph (3)(b) of Article 4 of the Order shall accordingly apply to this direction.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the said Article 4 HEREBY DIRECT THAT the permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to development of the description set out in Schedule 1 hereto on the land specified in Schedule 2 hereto, AND THAT this direction is made in pursuance of paragraph (3)(b) of Article 4 of the Order.

SCHEDULE 1 REFERRED TO

The use of land on not more than 14 days in total in any calendar year for the purpose of motor car or motor cycle racing and ancillary car-parking and the erection or placing of moveable structures on the land for the purposes of that use, being development comprised within Class IV paragraph 2 referred to in Schedule 1 to the Order and not being development comprised within any other Class.
