Direction made under Article 4(2)

WHEREAS the Council of the District of South Norfolk being the appropriate Local Planning Authority within the meaning of Article 4(6) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995, are satisfied that it is expedient that the development of the description(s) set out in the Schedule below should not be carried out on land at 126, 128, 130, 132 and 134 Norwich Road, Tacolneston, Norfolk, being the land shown edged / coloured red on the attached plan, unless permission is granted on an application made under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the power conferred on them by Article 4(2) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the description(s) set out in the Schedule below.

THIS DIRECTION is made under Article 4(2) of the said Order and, in accordance with Article 6(7), shall remain in force until 5 May 2009 (being six months from the date of this Direction) and shall then expire unless it has been confirmed by the Local Planning Authority.

Schedule 2 Part 1 - Development within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse

Class F

- The provision within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse of a hard surface for any purpose incidental to the enjoyment of the dwellinghouse as such.

Schedule 2 Part 2 - Minor Operations

Class A

- The erection, construction, maintenance, improvement or alteration of a gate, fence, wall or other means of enclosure.

Schedule 2 Part 31 - Demolition of buildings

Class B


- Any building operation consisting of the demolition of the whole or any part of any gate, fence, wall or other means of enclosure.
