This sum may be in the form of an online BACS payment, card, cash or bankers draft (made payable to Broadland District Council) and must be delivered to the Police Area Returning Officer at the Horizon Business Centre. Funds must be cleared before the nomination is considered valid.
- 5. If the election is contested, the poll will take place on Thursday, 2 May 2024
