- (5) Application has been made to the Council under reference number 88.1990 for planning permission for residential development to be carried out on the said piece or parcel of freehold land
- (6) The Council and the Executors have agreed subject to planning permission being granted in consequence of the aforesaid application to enter into this agreement pursuant to Section 52 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971 NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows:-
- 1. SUBJECT to planning permission being granted in consequence of application

Jointly and severally AGREE DECLARE AND COVENANT with the Council that from the date on which the aforesaid planning permission shall be granted the property shall be permanently subject to the condition restricting or regulating the development or use of the property specified in the Schedule hereto

2. THE expressions "the Council" and "the Executors" shall where the context so admits include their respective successors in title and assigns
