

day of The THIS AGREEMENT is made the May 1975 BETWEEN BROADLAND DISTRICT COUNCIL (hereinafter called "the Council") of the one part and RUSSELL MAURICE BLAKE of Hall Farm Postwick in the County of Norfolk (hereinafter called "the Owner") of the other part.

WHEREAS:

- (1) The Council is the Local Planning Authority for the purposes of this Agreement.
- (2) The Owner is seised in unincumbered fee simple in possession of the property described in the First Schedule (hereinafter called "the Property").

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows:-

- 1. Pursuant to Section 52 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 and in consideration of the Council's covenant hereinafter mentioned the Owner hereby agrees declares and covenants with the Council that the Property shall be subject to the conditions (restricting the development and/or use of the Property) specified in the Second Schedule hereto.
- 2. In consideration of Clause 1 hereof the Council hereby agree with the Owner to issue a planning consent for the erection of a farmhouse on land described in the First Schedule hereto (application number 75.0028).
- 3. The expressions "the Council" and "the Owner" shall where the context admits include their respective successors in title and assigns.

IN WITNESS whereof the Owner has hereunto set his Hand and Seal and the Council have hereunto affixed their Common Seal.
